

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY. Inflation came in higher-than-expected at 2.5% in June, mostly due to supply-side disruptions brought by lockdown measures. Risks to inflation targets are low as demand-side pressures on consumer prices are still muted given the uncertainties surrounding the pandemic. Downward bias for local interest rates is likely to continue. The Fund looks to invest in liquid fixed income securities and maintain portfolio duration within acceptable limits.



Personal consumption made the largest negative contribution, highlighting the effects of the pandemic on consumer demand. US Federal Reserve kept policy rates unchanged, but issued a dovish guidance as employment and economic activity remain below pre-pandemic levels. 

**RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS**. The Fund has deposits with EastWest Bank amounting to USD 1,272. These investment outlets were approved by the Board of Directors. Likewise, all related party transactions are conducted on best execution and arm's length basis.

**OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY** US-China tensions once again escalated as diplomatic missions in Houston and Chengdu were forced out of the US and China respectively. Both countries have accused each other of meddling in domestic affairs and this was just the latest barb in the ongoing tit-for-tat trade war. COVID-19 cases surpassed 16 million globally and continues to weigh on global markets. US stocks rallied on the back of the strong technology sector which is seen to benefit largely from the work from home setup brought about by the global quarantine. Expect US markets to continue with its rally as the Fed continues to keep rates accommodative and new stimulus bills are being drawn up in congress.

**PROSPECTIVE INVESTMENT**. The Fund's prospective investments, depending on availability and market development, may include but are not limited to, iShares Core S&P 500 ETF, Time Deposits, Government Securities and tradable fixed income securities issued by local financial institutions or private corporations. Investment in the iShares Core S&P 500 ETF may amount up to 100% of total assets but shall not fall below 90% of total assets of the Fund.
