RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS. The Fund has deposits with EastWest Bank amounting to USD 29,002. These investment outlets were approved by the Board of Directors. Likewise, all related party transactions are conducted on best execution and arm's length basis.

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY. Despite inflation running hot, US Federal Reserve officials reiterated that heightened inflation would remain temporary which calmed inflation jitters of investors. As the US Fed is anticipated to hold policy rates in the short-term, the S&P500 index has sustained its 4,200-level. Descending initial jobless claims figures also helped buoy stock prices. Reportedly, the US is one month away from herd immunity which is crucial in further economic reopening. Economic reopening could push corporate profits and may lift stock prices.

PROSPECTIVE INVESTMENT. The Fund's prospective investments, depending on availability and market development, may include but are not limited to, iShares Core S&P 500 ETF, Time Deposits, Government Securities and tradable fixed income securities issued by local financial institutions or private corporations. Investment in the iShares Core S&P 500 ETF may amount up to 100% of total assets but shall not fall below 90% of total assets of the Fund.
